As many of you may have heard, the Green Meadows complex survived the devastating fire that ravaged our Greenville community. Although we are grateful that Green Meadows is still standing, our hearts go out to those who have suffered insurmountable losses, as well as all of you who have been displaced.

As of the date of this letter, we do not have an estimate as to when you, our Green Meadows Tenants, can move back home. The complex sustained some damage, which will need to be repaired. There are also so many unknowns right now as far as the town itself and when folks will be allowed to move back home.

PCCDC will continue to work with HUD to ensure your status as a resident will remain in place during the difficult times ahead. You will not be responsible for rent, beginning August 1, 2021, and until you can resume your residency at Green Meadows Apartments.

It is our pledge to you, that PCCDC will work with community agencies and organizations and do whatever is necessary in order to bring you all back home as soon as possible.
